Excelsio Communications and TC3 LLC Complete Countywide Wireless Feasibility Study for Racine County, Wisconsin

December 6, 2005: Excelsio Communications, the market leader in pre-WiMAX and metro WiFi consulting and engineering services, and TC3, a mid-western regional voice and data consulting firm, announce the completion of their wireless feasibility study for Racine County, WI.

The study, developed for the entire 333 square miles of Racine County, was presented to the Finance Committee of the County Board on November 9th and a unanimous decision was made at that time to accept the report. The 100+ page report includes a study of area businesses and their telecom needs, a study of regulatory and digital inclusion for the County as well as high-level RF engineering plans and recommendations for the County.

“The County has significant resources including well-located tower structures and it has a hungry business community that we think will respond well to a wireless broadband offering,” said Bill Stark, President of Excelsio Communications. “We believe that the larger towns including Burlington and Racine can benefit from municipal WiFi service and the smaller, rural communities can benefit from a pre-WiMAX or 900MHz wireless offering where the household density is not as high.”

“The County is pleased with the work done thus far and we are excited about moving forward to complete our work – that is to bring wireless resources and investments to Racine County,” said Racine County Executive Bill McReynolds, “we are situated in a very unique geographical market, between Milwaukee and Chicago and we believe a strong market exists for business and consumer wireless broadband services. As we enhance our position as a place where knowledge workers and young professionals want to live and work, we need to insure that our residents and businesses have the tools they need to succeed; hence we are moving forward with the RFP development at this point. We expect to have the RFP on the street in late January or early February 2006.”

The small and larger towns in the County have spoken loud from our research and are anxious to have a wireless provider in their community,” said Dan Byers, President of TC3.
